

What is the photovoltaic effect?

The photovoltaic effect is a process that generates voltage or electric current in a photovoltaic cell when it is exposed to sunlight. It is this effect that makes solar panels useful, as it is how the cells within the panel convert sunlight to electrical energy. The photovoltaic effect was first discovered in 1839 by Edmond Becquerel.

What is a solar micro inverter?

Technically, solar micro inverters operate with lower DC input voltage levels than central units. They also manage the maximum power point tracking (MPPT) for each solar panel independently, allowing for more responsive and efficient energy conversion, especially under varied shading conditions or in case of solar panel malfunctions.

What is the difference between voltage and current for solar panels?

Maximum Power Voltage (V_{mp}): This is the voltage at which your panel operates most efficiently. If voltage is pressure, current (measured in amps) is the flow rate. While all solar cells with more than one bandgap are multijunction solar cells, a solar cell with exactly two bandgaps is called a tandem solar cell.
