

What percentage of solar PV installations are in Croatia?

Solar PV capacity accounted for 11.0% of total power plant installations globally in 2021, according to GlobalData, with total recorded solar PV capacity of 894GW. This is expected to contribute 26.1% by the end of 2030 with capacity of installations aggregating up to 3,206GW. Of the total global solar PV capacity, 0.01% is in Croatia.

Who owns a power station in Croatia?

All power stations in Croatia are owned and operated by Hrvatska elektroprivreda (HEP), the national power company. As of 2015, HEP operates 26 hydroelectric, 4 thermal and 3 cogenerating power plants with the total installed electrical power of 3.654 MW.

Is there a nuclear power plant in Croatia?

There are no nuclear power plants in the Republic of Croatia, but in the 1980s the Republic of Croatia and the Republic of Slovenia constructed the Krsko nuclear power plant (Krsko NPP) on the Slovenian territory. Presently, both states share the nuclear liability and the ownership of the Krsko NPP.
