

Is energy storage a good investment in Poland?

In Poland, interest in energy storage investment has been evident for some time. Last year's main auction of the power market, with capacity delivery for 2029, further bumped up the capacity of storage projects.

How big is Poland's energy capacity?

According to data from the Energy Market Agency, at the end of November 2024, Poland's installed capacity was about 20.7 GW, growing year-on-year by almost 28 percent, and the installed capacity of wind power plants was about 10.2 GW, increasing year-on-year by about 8 percent.

How much storage capacity does Poland have in 2024?

The Polish Economic Institute reported that in the power market's main auction, which was held in December 2024, storage capacity of around 2.5 GWwas contracted, indicating that this was a 44 percent increase over 2023, in which the total contracted for batteries was 1.7 GW.

Why do we need a new power plant in Poland?

Poland needs low- and zero-carbon new capacity, capable of flexible operation in a RES-based system. We need units that will support sector coupling, i.e. the combination of the power generation and heat sectors, the development of electromobility or the electrification of industry.

How will Poland integrate nuclear energy into its energy policy?

Poland aims to integrate nuclear energy into its Energy Policy of Poland 2040, with plans to operationalize its first nuclear reactor, having a capacity of 1,250 MW by 2036,3,750 MW by 2038, and to establish six reactors with a combined capacity of 6-9 GW by 2043.

How much electricity will Poland produce by 2040?

By 2040, offshore wind could provide 57% of Poland's electricity demand. By 2030, RES installations are expected to comprise 57% of Poland's electricity generation capacity, up from 44% in 2023. Photovoltaic installations are projected to increase from 19.6 GW in 2024 to 29.3 GW by 2030.
