

How many substations are there in Qatar?

It is a clear indication of the growth of the electricity sector in Qatar, accompanied by the remarkable expansion of main electricity transmission network, which led to an increase in the number of primary substations to 87 in 2000, which grew to 139 in 2008. As of May 2024, the number of primary substations has reached 393.

What is the supply voltage in Qatar?

In Qatar the supply voltage is 240V. If the appliance is a single voltage rated appliance, it will need to operate at the same voltage as the supply voltage of the country i.e. 240V. If this is not the case it should be used alongside a voltage transformer or converter to allow the appliance to work safely and properly.

What type of plug is used in Qatar?

In Qatar, type G plugs and sockets are the official standard. Like the rest of the Arabian Peninsula, Qatar has standardized on the British plug and outlet system. What is the mains voltage in Qatar?
