

Relationship between energy storage installed capacity and battery capacity

What is the difference between power capacity and energy storage capacity?

It can be compared to the nameplate rating of a power plant. Power capacity or rating is measured in megawatts (MW) for larger grid-scale projects and kilowatts (kw) for customer-owned installations. Energy storage capacity: The amount of energy that can be discharged by the battery before it must be recharged.

What is energy storage capacity?

Energy storage capacity is measured in megawatt-hours (MWh) or kilowatt-hours (kWh). Duration: The length of time that a battery can be discharged at its power rating until the battery must be recharged. The three quantities are related as follows: $\text{Duration} = \text{Energy Storage Capacity} / \text{Power Rating}$

Does battery size affect energy capacity?

Many factors affect the energy capacity rating and as the battery is often the most expensive component within a BESS, its sizing can significantly impact the cost-effectiveness of any solution. Even so, the energy storage industry does not yet have a common lexicon for discussing the end use energy capacity of a storage facility.

Storage duration is the amount of time storage can discharge at its power capacity before depleting its energy capacity.
