Does Saudi Arabia have a wind farm?

Furthermore, Saudi Arabia is currently engaged in wind power initiatives as part of its efforts to broaden its renewable energy portfolio. The Dumat Al Jandal wind project, considered the country's first utility-scale wind farm, is anticipated to possess a planned capacity of 400 MW.

Which projects will be developed in Saudi Arabia?

The consortium will develop photovoltaic (PV) solar projects: the 3GW Bisha project in the Asir region, the 3GW Humajj project in the Madinah region and the 2GW Khulis project in the Makkah region. The Afif 1 and Afif 2 projects in the Riyadh region, with a cumulative capacity of 4GW, will also be developed.

How much does Saudi Arabia's state-owned power procurement company sr31bn cost?

Saudi Arabia's state-owned power procurement company, Principal Buyer, has entered agreements worth SR31bn (\$8.3bn) with a consortium led by ACWA Power for the development of seven new solar and wind power projects with a combined capacity of 15GW.

How much solar power does Saudi Arabia have?

The kingdom had about 4.34 gigawatts of solar capacity as of the end of 2024, according to the Energy Institute's latest Statistical Review of World Energy, but wants to have up to 130GW of solar and wind capacity by the end of the decade. Almost all of Saudi Arabia's electricity is currently supplied by oil and gas-fired power plants.

How much power does Saudi Arabia need?

Saudi Arabia has established a goal to source at least 50 percent of its power from renewable energy by 2030, expanding its capacity to 130 gigawatts (GW), 58.7 GW of which is expected to come from solar and 40 GW from wind. This target is the most ambitious of its kind among Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries (Figure 1).

How many solar projects are there in Riyadh?

The central Riyadh region will have two solar and two wind projects, while the remaining solar projects will be in the regions of Mecca and Medina, as well as Aseer province. The projects should be up and running by 2028, according to a joint statement from ACWA Power and partners.
