

# Sodium bromide energy storage battery

Are bromide-based nonflammable electrolytes safe for sodium metal batteries?

What is a polysulfide-bromine battery?

The polysulfide-bromine battery (PSB; sometimes polysulphide-polybromide or "bromine-sulfur"), is a type of rechargeable electric battery, which stores electric energy in liquids, such as water-based solutions of two salts: sodium bromide and sodium polysulfide. It is an example and type of redox (reduction-oxidation) flow battery.

Are sodium metal batteries safe?

Sodium metal batteries (SMBs) are one of the most promising energy storage technologies owing to the rich abundance of sodium and its high gravimetric capacity. However, safe applications of SMBs are hindered by reactive sodium metal and the highly flammable electrolyte, which leads to dendritic growth, gassing and fire issues.

How long does a BBE based electrolyte last?

The BBE-based electrolyte prolongs the cycle life (80% capacity retention) of Na<sub>3</sub>V<sub>2</sub>(PO<sub>4</sub>)<sub>3</sub>/Na cells from 60 cycles in traditional electrolytes to 1500 cycles and produces a stable cycle life of 1400 h in the Na/Na symmetric cells. We further demonstrated a sodium metal pouch cell showing a capacity retention of 97.9% after 264 cycles at 1C.

What is the voltage of a NABR electrolyte?

The cell comprising the 1.4 M EASSP and 4 M NaBr electrolytes exhibited a cell voltage of 2.79 V with charge-discharge capacities of 17.6 and 15.4 mAh, respectively (Fig. 5 a). When the anolyte concentration was constant, and the molar concentration of the catholyte was changed to 6 M, the cell voltage decreased to 2.60 V (Fig. 5 b).
