How many solar panels do you need to power a house?

How much power does a solar panel use?

Solar panel power ratings range from 250W to 450W. Based on solar.com sales data, 400W is the most popular power rating and provides a great balance of output and Price Per Watt (PPW). If you have limited roof space, you may consider a higher power rating to use fewer panels. If you want to spend less per panel, you may consider a lower wattage.

How many solar panels can you put on a roof?

If you want to calculate how many solar panels you can put on your roof, you will obviously need to know the size of a solar panel. Example: 5kW solar system is comprised of 50 100-watt solar panels.
