What is energy storage system (ESS) in South Korea?

Why should South Korea deploy long-duration storage?

What ESS Technologies are used in Korea?

Major ESS technologies practiced in Korea are mechanical energy storage (MES), electrochemical energy storage (ECES), chemical energy storage (CES) and thermal energy storage (TES), which are shortly described in Table 1.
