What is an isolated power supply?

If you have a power supply with isolated outputs, you essentially have several different power supplies - to the pedals, each output appears as its own separate power supply. This is a good setup, since keeping the pedals on their own isolated power sources stops them from interacting through the power lines.

Is it possible to split a power supply?

@user1587736 yes your splitting is not an issue- parallel runs,the length of your runs is very short. I would just run them directly from the power supply - if you do not desire that - buy a two wire terminal tab. connect to power supply and run wires equally from terminal tab to lights - search for 3 Pin Compact Wire terminal.
