Can solar panels be installed in Switzerland?

Typically, solar panels in Switzerland are mounted on existing infrastructure like mountain huts, ski lifts, and dams, with larger-scale installations in the Alps remaining rare. On September 10, 2023, 54% of Valais voters rejected Alpine solar project proposals due to environmental and aesthetic concerns.

In 2022, Switzerland derived 6% of its electricity from solar power. Studies show that installing solar panels on mountaintops in the Swiss Alps could produce at least 16 terawatt-hours (TWh) a year, approaching half of the nation's 2050 solar energy target.

How many MW is a photovoltaic system in Switzerland?

In 2021, Switzerland's photovoltaic (PV) installations increased to 685 MWp from 475 MWp in 2020. The Federal Energy Act, revised and effective from January 1, 2018, changed the support scheme for PV systems: it extended the one-time investment subsidy to all sizes of PV systems, ranging from 2 kW to 50 MW.

Can solar panels be installed on a south-facing wall?

Wall-mounted solar panels are typically installed as modules on a south-facing wall. It's not logical to install your solar panels on a wall that isn't south-facing since wall-mounted systems already have setbacks in their energy generation due to their slope.

Do wall-mounted solar panels produce more electricity in the winter?

In general, wall-mounted solar panels generate more electricity during the winter months than they do in the summer. This is because the sun is lower in the sky, allowing more direct sunlight to hit wall-mounted panel angles. Roof and ground-mounted solar panels produce more energy than wall mounts in the summer since the sun is higher in the sky.
