

# The actual power of photovoltaic panels is about what percentage

What is the rated power of a solar panel?

The rated power of a solar panel is the maximum power that the solar panel can produce if everything is working at peak efficiency. For example, if the panel is rated at 200 watts, then the rated power is 200 watts, and that is the most power that the panel can create. Will it create that much power?

How do you calculate the efficiency of a solar panel?

Then the efficiency of a PV cell is defined as being: Where efficiency,  $\eta$  (eta) is the solar panel efficiency,  $P_{MAX}$  is the maximum electrical power, divided by the sum of the panel area (A) in  $m^2$ , to the irradiance intensity (E) measured in watts-per-metre-squared ( $W/m^2$ ).
