Can a DC-link capacitor voltage balancing technique be applied to a 51-anpc inverter?

The proposed technique can be applied to any 5L-ANPC inverter topologies. A 1 kW single-phase 7S-5L-ANPC inverter experimental prototype is built to verify the effectiveness of the proposed DC-link capacitor voltages balancing technique.

How does a fixed reactive power inverter work?

In fact, the deviation of the reactive power can be used to generate the internal voltage reference [11, 24]. Under fixed reactive power mode, the inverter injects a set amount of reactive power according to some set point in the same manner as the grid-tracking control scheme.

How to design the control of the inverter?

In order to design the control of the inverter, the small-signal model of the power stage must first be obtained . To do so, Kirchhoff's Voltage Law (KVL) and Kirchhoff's Current Law (KCL) are used.

How to control reactive power injection in a PV inverter?
