

What should you know about lithium ion batteries?

The most important key parameter you should know in lithium-ion batteries is the nominal voltage. The standard operating voltage of the lithium-ion battery system is called the nominal voltage. For lithium-ion batteries, the nominal voltage is approximately 3.7-volt per cell which is the average voltage during the discharge cycle.

What causes low voltage in a lithium battery?

Root cause 1: High self-discharge, which causes low voltage. Solution: Charge the bare lithium battery directly using the charger with over-voltage protection, but do not use universal charge. It could be quite dangerous. Root cause 2: Uneven current.

What happens if battery voltage is below 2V?

If the voltage is below 2V,the internal structure of lithium battery will be damaged,and the battery life will be affected. Root cause 1: High self-discharge,which causes low voltage. Solution: Charge the bare lithium battery directly using the charger with over-voltage protection,but do not use universal charge. It could be quite dangerous.

What is the voltage of a lithium ion battery?

Additionally, the voltage of lithium-ion battery systems may differ slightly due to variations in the specific chemistry. For example, the nominal voltage of LiFePO4 batteries (a lithium-based popular alternative) is 3.2V per cell which is significantly lower than Litium-ion batteries' average voltage (3.7V).

What is a safe voltage for a lithium ion battery?

Lithium-ion batteries function within a certain range at which their voltage operates optimally and safely. The highest range where the fully charged voltage of a lithium-ion battery is approximately 4.2V per cell. The lowest range which is the minimum safe voltage for lithium-ion batteries is approximately 3.0V per cell.

When is a lithium ion battery fully discharged?

A lithium-ion battery is considered "dead" or fully discharged when its voltage drops to around 3.0V per cell or lower. In many cases, devices will automatically shut off when the voltage hits about 3.2V to prevent over-discharge, which can permanently damage the battery.
