How much power does Uganda have?

As of September 2024, Uganda's installed national generation capacity was 2,048.1 MW of electricity. Capacity in 2009 was 14.5 megawatts. Both grid and off-grid connections account for 42% of access to electricity in Uganda. The term grid connection refers to access to power through the national electricity grid. The Uganda National Household Survey 2019/2020 states that the Ugandan electricity grid reaches 18.9 % of Ugandans, mainly in urban areas.

In addition to the challenges in the generation and distribution of electricity, there are significant hurdles on the consumer side. A substantial portion of the Ugandan population are having limited financial resources, 60% of Ugandans earned 200,000 UGX (50 EUR) per month in 2022.

How much does electricity cost in Uganda?

A substantial portion of the Ugandan population are having limited financial resources, 60% of Ugandans earned 200,000 UGX (50 EUR) per month in 2022. The tariffs for electricity are based on consumption, the first 15 kWh per month can be bought for each 250 UGX (~0.06 EUR), every additional unit costs 747.5 UGX (0.18 EUR).
