How many Ukrainian mobile stations have been rebuilt?

As of Oct. 13, Ukrainian mobile operators have rebuilt 71 of their base stations in towns and cities liberated from Russian occupation since the beginning of the counter-offensive last month, according to figures shared with TIME by Ukraine's Digital Ministry.

How many base stations are there in Ukraine?

"We've had more than 10 percent of our sites completely or partially destroyed," explains Sasha Ananyev, head of the network operation department at Vodafone Ukraine. That's roughly 1,400 base stations, and does not include base stations located in Donetsk and Luhansk, areas that have been occupied by Russia since 2014.

What is Ukraine's Telecommunication Development Plan?

Ukraine's telecommunication development plan emphasizes further improving domestic trunk lines, international connections, and the mobile cellular system. During the Russian invasion of Ukraine, telecommunications were provided by the Starlink satellite service.

How will telecommunications help Ukraine regain territory?

As Ukraine begins to regain territory, telecommunications systems will be some of the first categories of infrastructure to be rebuilt, and in turn, will facilitate the digital transformation of different sectors and regions. Prior to the war, Ukraine was known for its thriving ICT and digital ecosystem.

How many telecommunications lines have been seized in Ukraine?

More than 4,000 base stations belonging to Ukrainian telecommunications providers have been seized or destroyed by Russian soldiers since the beginning of the invasion, and more than 60,000 kilometers of fiber-optic lines used for Internet have been captured or damaged, according to Ukraine's Special Communications Service.

Is Ukraine still a good place to invest in telecommunications?

In June 2023, as part of the London Ukraine Recovery Conference, an investment pledge of \$600 million to the Ukrainian mobile servicer, Kyivstar, was made by Veon, a Dutch-based telecommunications company. Competition in the sector continues to be strong with many companies still present in Ukraine--yet another good sign for investors.
