

Did Ukraine get a loan to build a battery energy storage complex?

What does DTEK's new energy storage system mean for Ukraine?

The new project aims to strengthen Ukraine's energy security and support the transition to a greener energy system. DTEK Group aims to commission the new storage systems by September 2025.

Who is funding the energy storage project in Ukraine?

Ukraine's second most profitable bank, state-owned Oschadbank, state-owned Ukrgasbank, and PUMB will provide the funding for the project, which includes six energy storage installations across the country, totaling 200 megawatts to power 600,000 households.

Will Russia attack Ukraine's energy facilities?

" This system is bringing more resilience to the energy system, " DTEK 's CEO Maxim Timchenko said at a press briefing on Sept. 10, later adding that he anticipates Russia will resume heavy attacks on Ukraine's energy facilities. Initially, a press tour was arranged at one of the battery sites in Kyiv Oblast on Sept. 10.

Could battery energy storage be a path to decentralization and unification?

The company sees battery energy storage facilities as a path to decentralization and unification with the EU. In March,DTEK announced it was building Poland's first large electricity storage facility as part of its plan to establish a pan-European energy system connected to Ukraine.

Is DTEK the largest private investment in Ukraine's energy sector?

It marked the largest ever private investment in Ukraine's energy sector. Unlike other state-owned energy companies in Ukraine,DTEK hasn't been able to secure funding from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD).
