How to charge an inverter battery?

How do I connect a charge controller to a 48v battery?

Connect the Charge Controller to the Battery: Attach the charge controller's output terminals to the 48V battery. Ensure correct polarity--positive to positive and negative to negative. Add the Inverter (if necessary): If you plan to use AC devices, connect the inverter's input to the battery.

Typically, an inverter may take anywhere from 6 to 12 hours to full charge a standard tubular battery. The key influencer here is the charger's output capacity--higher capacities result in faster charging times.
