

Why is Uzbekistan halting natural gas exports?

Driven by rapidly increasing domestic energy demand, Uzbekistan has shifted from being an energy exporter to an importer since 2020,. As a result, the government has planned to halt natural gas exports to meet the country's needs.

How many solar projects are there in Uzbekistan?

National Projects: Tenlarge-scale solar projects totaling 2,050 MW have been put out to tender in Uzbekistan,primarily in the southern and southwestern regions. As of August 2021,1,300 MW had been awarded,and the 100 MW project in the Navoi region began operations in August 2021.

Should Uzbekistan decarbonize the energy sector?

Decarbonizing the energy sector is essential to achieving these targets. Natural gas dominates Uzbekistan's energy mix,making up 83% of the total,while renewable energy,primarily hydropower,contributes just 1%. Similarly,natural gas accounts for 82% of electricity generation,with hydropower contributing 9%.
