Saudi Arabian developer ACWA Power has signed a binding implementation agreement with the Ministry of Energy (MoE) of Uzbekistan to develop up to 2 GWh of standalone battery energy storage system (BESS) capacity across the country.

What is the energy sector like in Uzbekistan?

In Uzbekistan,the energy sector is concentrated in the hands of two monopolies,Uzbekenergo and Uzbekneftegaz,with mineral resources and rare-earth minerals concentrated at metallurgy plants,which the government intends to upgrade through a number of sponsored programmes, and with the active assistance of foreign contractors and suppliers.

Who will sell electricity to in Uzbekistan?

The project company is committed to selling electricity to the state-owned National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan JSCunder a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement for the project, including a 10-year operating term for the BESS component, signed by these two entities.
