

# What are the energy management systems for base stations in Oman

What percentage of Oman has access to electricity?

According to the World Bank, access to electricity amount to 98.0 %. The Oman Power and Water Procurement Company (OPWP) is the planning body for power supplies in the country. OPWP is responsible for securing electricity and water production capacities in the country and the single buyer of power and water for all IPP/IWPP projects.

What is the main energy source in Oman?

Unlike the national energy production, gas accounts for the largest amount of primary energy supply in Oman (18,040 ktoe), followed by crude oil (9,927 ktoe). Oman is a fossil fuel exporting country. In 2011, the country was exporting 39,481 ktoe of crude oil, 2,152 ktoe of oil products and 9,797 ktoe of natural gas.

Who is responsible for Oman's electricity network?

Established in 2003, the Oman Electricity Transmission Company is in charge of the country's electricity transmission networks. What is Oman's energy plan?

The plan also aims to improve energy efficiency, targeting 6 megajoules per US dollar of GDP by 2050. Additionally, Oman seeks to achieve 100% sales of new zero-emission vehicles by 2050 and reach green hydrogen production milestones of 1 million tonnes by 2030, 3.5 million tonnes by 2040, and 8 million tonnes by 2050.
