A mobile phone base station provides coverage to a geographic area known as a "cell". Cells are aligned next to each other in a similar pattern to a honeycomb, and it is for this reason that mobile phone networks are sometimes referred to as "cellular" networks.

What cellular networks use base station antennas?

Different generations of cellular networks 2G,3G,4G or 5Gwill use base station antennas operating at different frequency bands to transmit and receive signals that carry voice,data,text etc.

What is a base station in a cellular network?

Base Stations A base station, often housed within a cell site, is the central point in a cellular network where signals are transmitted and received from mobile devices. It consists of electronic equipment, including transceivers, antennas, and signal processors, that manage the communication within a specific geographical area or "cell."

These base stations generate the radio signals that ultimately constitute the cell. This is the only way to make sure transmissions from neighbouring network ...

In LTE (Long Term Evolution) networks, these base stations are known as eNodeBs (evolved Node Bs), while in 5G networks, they are referred to as gNodeBs (next-generation Node Bs).
