

What is battery energy storage capacity?

Battery energy storage capacity is the total amount of energy the battery can store,measured in kilowatt-hours (kWh) or megawatt-hours (MWh). Think of this as like the size of a water tank where you measure the water capacity in litres.

### What does Ah mean in a battery?

Amp Hours(Ah) measure the amount of electric charge a battery can deliver over time. 1Ah = 1 amp of current for 1 hour (For example: 0.5A for 2 hours,2A for 30 minutes,etc.) 2. Why Ah Matters: Runtime &Performance Runtime (hours) = Battery Ah ÷ Device Amp Draw Example: 100Ah battery ÷ 5A device = 20 hours

#### How long does a 4 MW battery last?

A 4 MWh battery with a 1 MW power rating has a 4-hourduration. A 1 MWh battery with a 2 MW power rating has a 0.5-hour duration. We've written about storage duration in more detail here. C-rate or 'charge rate', is another way of defining how quickly a battery can be charged or discharged relative to its storage capacity.
