How do Photocell sensors work?

Photocell sensors work like a timer switch in that they power light fixtures off and on automatically during a set "time". They work a little bit differently though than timer switches because photocell sensors sense the natural light of the sun for controlling artificial light output from lighting fixtures. How does a photocell work?

A photocell works by changing its resistance based on the amount of light it receives. In the dark, the resistance is high, and as light intensity increases, the resistance decreases. The resistance can be measured using a multimeter or by connecting the photocell to a circuit and measuring the voltage across it.

What is a photocell based on?

The concept behind the photocell is based on the photoelectric effect, where light energy is absorbed by a material, causing electrons to be released and creating a current flow. There are two main types of photocells: Cadmium Sulfide (CdS) and Silicon (Si). CdS photocells are the most common type and are inexpensive.
