China Telecom is targeting 300,000 5G base stations across China by the end of 2020. China Mobile expects its 5G network to reach 300 cities across China by the end of 2020. It was reported that China had more than 65 million 5G subscribers by the end of March 2020.

What frequency bands does China have for 5G?

China's Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT) held the auction for 5G spectrum bands in December 2018. Country's telecom operators acquired spectrum in 2.5 GHz, 3.5 GHz and 4.8 GHz (n41, n78 and n79) bands. China has allocated the following frequency bands for 5G:

Does China Mobile have 5G?

China Mobile launched their 5G service in late 2019 while China Unicom and China Telecom started rolling out 5G in 2020. In a report by Bloomberg in June 2020, tests conducted on China Mobile 5G network in Beijing showed the 5G service was consistent enough to play high-definition (1080p) video while riding in a car.

What is 5G network?

5G network achieves co-arrangement with other networks and capability exposure through a unified coordination and orchestration layer of the entire network. 5G network should make use of the advantages of fixed network resources and leverage fixed mobile con

Will China mobile 5G reach 300 cities in 2020?

China Mobile expects its 5G network to reach 300 cities across China by the end of 2020. It was reported that China had more than 65 million 5G subscribers by the end of March 2020. In April 2020, China Telecom, in partnership with Spirent Communications, successfully completed a Standalone (SA) 5G network verification for scaled deployment.

In 2023, China Unicom will continue to promote the construction of a 900MHz low-frequency network. It will build no less than this year's number of 900MHz base stations.

China Telecom is also engaged in the work of expanding 5G coverage from land to sea, a successful example of this being the deployment of marine 5G networks based on 2.1 ...
