How much electricity does Gabon use?

Gabon's total consumption of electricity in 2015 was estimated at 169 ktoe. Though most oil-dependent, in recent years, Gabon has attempted to diversify its energy schedule by including hydropower generation. This is evident in its existing hydropower infrastructure and their plans to create new structures.

Who is responsible for the energy sector in Gabon?

The Ministry of Petroleum and Gas and the Ministry of Energy and Hydraulic Resources share responsibility for the energy sector. SEEG, the national electricity and water service company of Gabon, was under a concession to the French company Veolia from 1997.

What is the energy potential of Gabon?

More than 90% of Gabon is forested and 8.4% is covered by agricultural land [9,10]. Which is a very rich resource for bioenergy production. Hydropower potential of the country is estimated to be 6 000 MW. Potential for the use of ocean energy and sea wave energy in the south of the country can reach 10 kW/m . Table 2.

Does Gabon have a hydropower monopoly?

In 2019, SEEG was renationalized and holds the monopoly on power production and distribution. Gabon hydropower provides more than half (51 percent) of Gabon's current 2,000 gigawatt (gw) of electricity per year, from an installed capacity of 720 megawatt (mw).

Does Gabon produce electricity from fossil fuels?

The production and consumption of fossil fuels in Gabon (coal - left, gas - in the center, oil - right) Historically, Gabon has a high share of hydropower in electricity production, but in recent years most of the electricity has been produced from fossil sources (Fig 3.).
