

What is a battery ampere-hours (Ah)?

Ampere-hours (Ah) is a measure of the battery's capacity to deliver a current over time. It represents the amount of charge a battery can hold and provide at a specific rate of discharge. Current,measured in amperes (amps),refers to the flow of electric charge.

What is an example of a high ampere-hour battery?

In practical terms,a battery with a higher ampere-hour rating will have a greater capacity to provide power over an extended period. For example, a battery rated at 10 Ahcan deliver 10 amps of current for one hour, or 1 amp for 10 hours. Voltage is the electrical potential difference that drives the flow of current through a circuit.
