Which wind turbines will power the future Scott Base?

Ross Island, Antarctica is set to receive three new state-of-the-art wind turbines that will power the future Scott Base with more than 90% renewable energy. Three EWT turbines (type DW54X-1MW) have been selected to replace the three existing turbines that supply renewable energy to Scott Base and the neighbouring American base, McMurdo Station.

Are there any wind turbines in New Zealand?

Only wind turbines and farms over 5 MW generating capacity are listed. Individual demonstration and prototype wind turbines have been installed at Southbridge in Canterbury, Gebbies Pass near Christchurch and Brooklyn in Wellington. Many small windmills serve as windpumps on New Zealand farms.

Will New Zealand benefit from a new wind base?

The upgrade will allow New Zealand to benefit from the extreme wind conditions in Antarctica, while meeting the higher energy requirements of the new base that is due to be up and running in 2028.

Why is wind generation quieter in New Zealand?

Improving technology and noise standards for turbines have also made wind generation quieter. Why is wind a useful resource in New Zealand?

High average wind speeds make wind a useful generation resource in New Zealand. Currently, just over 6% of New Zealand's electricity is generated from wind turbines. This is projected to significantly increase in coming years with several wind farms under construction, planned or under investigation.

Over three-quarters (512 MW) of the country's wind generation is installed within a 150 km (93 mi) radius of Palmerston North, with some turbines in the area having a capacity factor of over 50 ...
