

Why are energy storage systems important?

Energy storage systems,mostly large batteries, are important because they help store solar and wind power for use when the sun isn't shining or the wind isn't blowing. In 2025, over 31 GW of new storage capacity is expected to be built. California and Texas are the leaders in battery storage.

How many GW of solar power will be installed this year?

The Energy Information Administration projects that 32.5 GW of solar power,18.2 GW of energy storage, and 7.7 GW of wind generation will be deployed this year, accounting for nearly 93% of total new capacity, which is expected to reach a record 63 GW.

Why is storage growth important?

Storage growth is important because it makes renewable energy more reliable. Batteries can help keep the grid stable and reduce blackouts. Wind energy is still expanding, though not as fast as solar. More than 2 GW of new wind capacity is expected in Texas alone in 2025, and around 2 GW more across the rest of the country.

How many GW of battery storage will be built in 2025?

In 2025, over 31 GW of new storage capacity is expected to be built. California and Texas are the leaders in battery storage. The California Independent System Operator (CAISO) is set to add about 6 GW of storage next year, while Texas plans to add nearly 12 GW.
